Professors made observations and advice regarding the master's program, including some observations of how to continue the program and its needs for sustainability and validity.

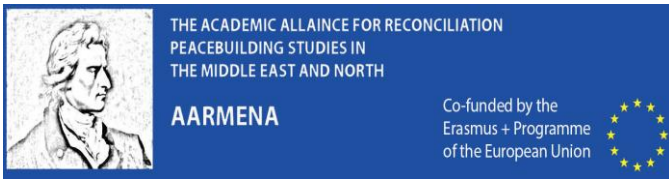
